Live Free Checklist:

- Provide staff with a copy of the Live Free fact sheet so they will be aware of the campaign and its purpose.
- Encourage teachers to include the concept of "living free" in their teaching. This will start discussions of what students might live free of.
- Use the school announcement scripts to remind students to live free and bring in their Toonies on March 2nd or when you are doing your Live Free campaign.
- Make sure all students and staff fill out a promise card and place them on display in classrooms and in hallways.
- Live Free day is on **Friday March 2nd** - ensure all toonies and donations are collected and placed back in the Live Free Campaign box.
- Children's Foundation staff and volunteers will collect all donations and you will be notified of how much your school raised. A cheque will be handed out during the Food & Friends Spring Network meeting in April.
